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Activity: World of Work

Did you know what you wanted to do for a job when you were 14 years old? World of work is an opportunity for students to find out what real life jobs are about. Through a Q&A session, students will be able to ask you questions about your job and the company you work for. For example, questions like; what does your place of work look like? What do you do day-to-day? Did you go to college?

This is a fun activity which helps students not only make better choices with their GCSE options, but it gives them a first encounter with a professional. You will spend around 20 minutes with students, and then they'll move on as another group comes to see you. If you have any handouts, freebies or even a video on a laptop, bring it along and show our students what it looks like in the world of work.

Activity: Work Preparation – Personal Branding/CV Workshop

The CV Workshop looks to help students develop the knowledge needed to create a CV that beats everyone to that job of their dreams. Through looking at the different variations of CV that are used in the modern day, we help students understand the do's and don'ts of CV creation, as well as a what can make their personal CV stand out from the rest.

Interview Prep is aimed at giving students the chance to learn and prepare themselves for what an interview entails. Through conversation and sharing experiences, students get the opportunity to take tips and tricks away for their future interviews in work or college.

Volunteers are able to work with students during various activities that happen throughout the session. This is a great day for someone who wants to share their knowledge and experiences with young people without having to lead the students through the session. No prior experience is needed as briefing provided for you on the day.

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Activity: Mock Interviews

Do you want to help and support young people who have not had the chance to grow the skills needed for employment? Do you want to provide them with the chance to grow in confidence to enter the world of work? Mock interviews may be the event for you.

You will act as an interviewer for Year 10 and 11 pupils. You will be given generic interview questions to ask the students but can also improvise and ask your own. No prior experience is needed as briefing and resources are all provided for you on the day. Mock interviews are a simple but rewarding event to take part in.

Activity: Tycoon Launch

We launch our search for the next tycoon. Tycoon Launch is an enterprise challenge that places year 7-9 students into small enterprise teams competing against each other to design a product for potential investors. Teams must consider their target market, budget considerations and marketing strategies before producing a prototype and pitching to a panel of business representatives and the other teams in the room.

As a volunteer, you'll have the opportunity to get alongside students and play a supporting mentoring role throughout the day. A great activity to get involved with if you are looking at promoting entrepreneurialism and highlighting some essential skills needed for the world of work. The best part is that no prior experience is needed as briefing and resources are all provided for you on the day. This is a fun and exciting day to get involved with.
