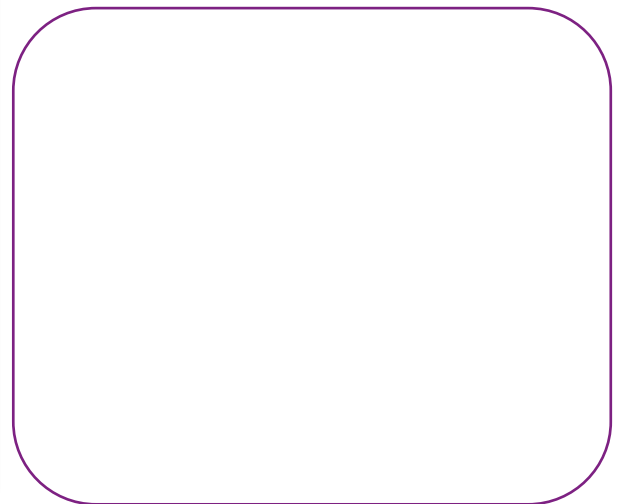
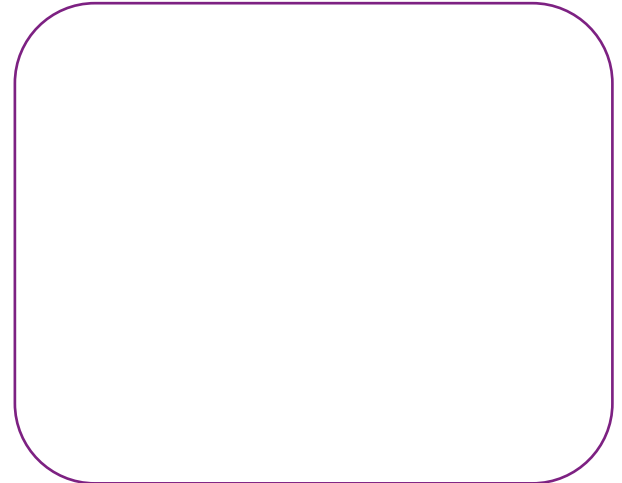
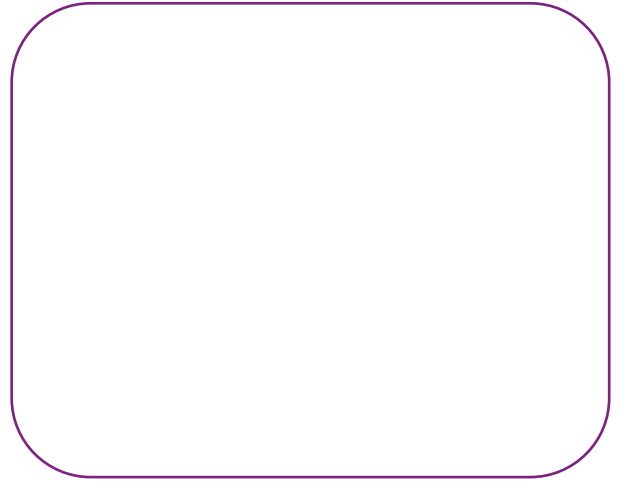


Non- Verbal Communication - Tell Me about This Scene
