How is the course delivered?

- 2 week course 4 days per week at **Foundation House**, 9.30am-3.30pm
- One to one & small groups of 6 people - all socially distanced
- 50 young people supported in total
- After care for up to 7 months for those in work, education or within the community

What's in it for you?

- ✓ **Coaching & mentoring** - to help you choose your careers, set goals and become ready for work
- ✓ **Workshops** - on preparing your CV, applying for jobs and preparing for interviews
- ✓ **CSCS Labourers Card** - Access to IT suite, practice tests and the CITB mobile app to prepare for CSCS card needed to work on construction sites
- ✓ **Qualifications** - gain new upskilling qualification to start your career
- ✓ **Work trials** - not sure what job you want, try out a new role or trade
- ✓ **Site Visits** - visit a site linked with our construction partners
- ✓ **Work placements** - gain some real experience of the world of work and get feedback from a potential employer
- ✓ **Kickstart scheme** - access up to 6 months paid work and training
- ✓ **Paid jobs** - access to job vacancies, agencies and employers to secure a job
- ✓ **Progression** - to further training, traineeships, apprenticeships and full time work
