Safe & Strong Communities

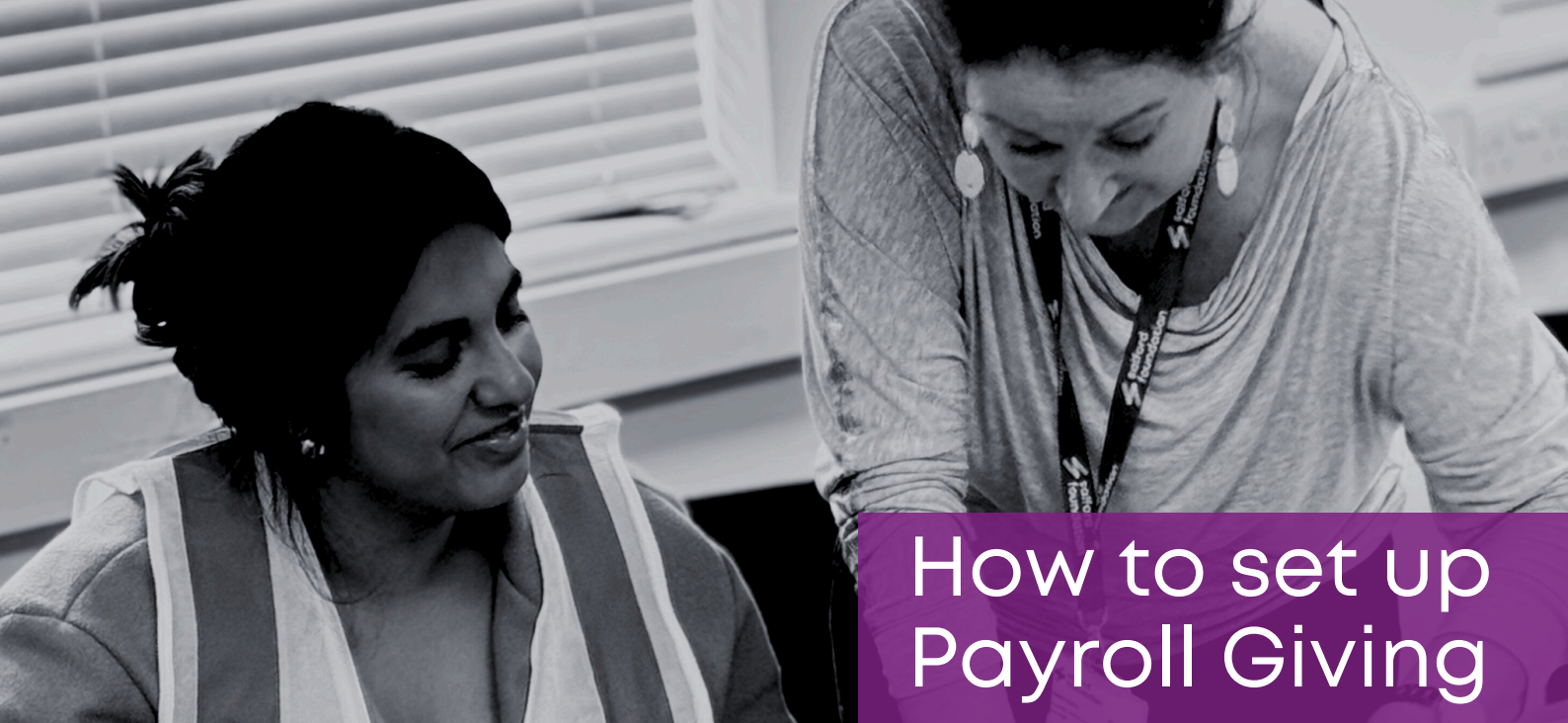
Inclusive, supportive communities. Preventing domestic abuse, preventing people being drawn into crime, helping people in the criminal justice system rebuild positive and productive lives.

What is payroll giving?

Payroll Giving, also known as GAYE (Give As You Earn) is a simple, tax-efficient way for employees to donate to Salford Foundation directly from their salary. It's automatic, secure, and makes a lasting impact.

This means you get tax relief on your donations, as the donation is taken before tax is calculated on your income.

- **Provides regular, long-term income streams – helping Salford Foundation plan more effectively for expenditure**
- **Removes the need to claim Gift Aid – saving Salford Foundation valuable time and money**
- **If you pay the basic 20% tax rate and donate £10 each month, Salford Foundation will receive £10, but only £8 will be deducted from your net pay**

How to set up Payroll Giving

1. Check if your employer or pension provider offers Payroll Giving. You can ask your HR department or pension provider if they have a scheme.
2. If they do, request the necessary forms or information to sign up.
3. Choose your charity/charities (e.g: Salford Foundation)
4. Decide on the amount you wish to donate.
5. Complete the forms and submit them to your employer or pension provider.
6. Your donations will then be deducted from your monthly gross pay or pension payments.
